- ✚ the decrease in ordinary collections overall

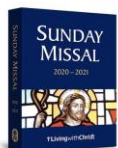

NEW PANDEMIC PROTOCOLS

As of this day (Dec 13) the attendance that we allow in our churches is limited to 15% of the seating capacity of the nave. Our seating capacity for this Church is about 30.

All persons (except those legitimately excused) must be masked throughout the service. You must enter the church masked, and at the end leave masked until outside.

Those from a common cohort may be seated together. Each person in a cohort is counted as an individual person. The cohort is not counted as one person.
