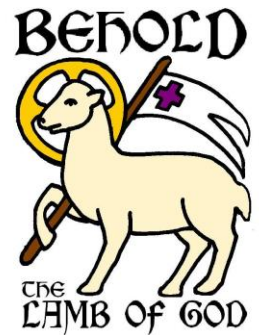

## PANDEMIC PROTOCOLS

As of this day (Dec 13) the attendance that we allow in our churches is limited to 15% of the seating capacity of the nave. Our seating capacity for this Church is about 30.

Those from a common cohort may be seated together. Each person in a cohort is counted as an individual person. The cohort is not counted as one person.

## SACRAMENTS 2021



For all those who have children needing to prepare for and celebrate the **Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation** and do not attend **St. Mary's School** please contact Fr. Michael or the Parish Office – 780.354.2415

~According to Church law and practice, (Canon 914) the sacrament of Reconciliation must be received before the child receives the Eucharist for the first time. This is normally to be prepared for and celebrated in grade two, or at about age seven. A child's first sharing fully in the Eucharist is normally to be prepared for and celebrated in grade three, or at about age eight. The sacrament of Confirmation is usually prepared for and celebrated in grade 6 or about age 11 ~ *Archdiocese of Grouard-McLennan Policy 2.4.1 and 2.6.1*
