

SACRAMENTS 2021



For all those who have children needing to prepare for and celebrate the **Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation** and do not attend **St. Mary's School** please contact Fr. Michael or the Parish Office – 780.354.2415

~According to Church law and practice, (Canon 914) the sacrament of Reconciliation must be received before the child receives the Eucharist for the first time. This is normally to be prepared for and celebrated in grade two, or at about age seven. A child's first sharing fully in the Eucharist is normally to be prepared for and celebrated in grade three, or at about age eight. The sacrament of Confirmation is usually prepared for and celebrated in grade 6 or about age 11 ~ *Archdiocese of Grouard-McLennan Policy 2.4.1and 2.6.1*

You are required to pre-register on our parish website to participate Sunday's and Ash Wednesday's Masses.

We have implemented EVENBRITE (a software application which you can easily download on your cellphone/computer) for Mass pre – registration. It is made available now on our parish website. You may go ahead and pre-register from Feb 7th onward. Those who do not have access to internet, may request a friend or family member to submit registration on their behalf. The app also allows you to cancel your pre-registration in case if you cannot attend the service. We would like to make sure that those requesting assistants to pre-register have confirmation.
