

PANDEMIC PROTOCALS

As of this day (Dec 1 3) the attendance that we allow in our churches is limited to 15% of the seating capacity of the nave. Our seating capacity for this Church is 30. All persons (except those legitimately excused) must be masked throughout the service. You must enter the church masked, and at the end leave masked until outside.

Those from a common cohort may be seated together. Each person in a cohort is counted as an individual person. The cohort is not counted as one person. We thank you for your patience. While these measures place a burden on us all, let us stand out in our patience and our desire to serve one another.

Ash Wednesday - Day of Fasting and Abstinence

Feb 17th begins the holy season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, but it is one of the two days in Canada of prescribed fast and abstinence. (The other is Good Friday.) In this instance, fasting means you consume noticeably less food on that day (one meal and two small "snacks"); abstinence means you eat no meat or meat products. All Fridays of Lent are days of Lenten observance, but the manner of this observance is left to the individual.

SACRAMENTS 2021



For all those who have children needing to prepare for and celebrate the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation and do not attend St. Mary's School please contact Fr. Michael or the Parish Office — 780.354.2415

~According to Church law and practice, (Canon 914) the sacrament of Reconciliation must be received before the child receives the Eucharist for the first time. This is normally to be prepared for and celebrated in grade two, or at about age seven. A child's first sharing fully in the Eucharist is normally to be prepared for and celebrated in grade three, or at about age eight. The sacrament of Confirmation is usually prepared for and celebrated in grade 6 or about age 11 ~ Archdiocese of Grouard-McLennan Policy 2.4.1and 2.6.1
