We also welcome any flower donations to help decorate the Altar and Sanctuary

Relaxed and permitted

1. A procession with cross-bearer, 2 candles-bearers, the Book of Gospels, and presider. Masked and keeping 2 metre distance between participants.
2. Congregational singing will be allowed but masks must be worn over mouth and nose while singing.
3. Song leader, choir members and cantor must practice 2 metre distance between participants and continue to be masked while singing. Sharing of microphones is discouraged.
4. Wind instruments are not permitted.
5. On reaching the sanctuary, altar servers are to keep 2 metre distance for each other. They do not serve as acolytes at the altar.
6. Holy water may be placed in fonts for use but should be changed after every liturgy.
7. Reception of communion of the Precious Blood is limited to the celebrant and concelebrants (using individual chalices or by intinction).
8. A recessional procession following the same requirements as the entrance procession.
9. Proper sanitation of cross and candles is to be observed.
