MISSIONARY MONTH – OCTOBER 2022

The Celebration of World Mission Sunday, October 23, 2022

World Mission Sunday takes place on the third Sunday of October. The primary purpose of World Mission Sunday is to unite Catholics all over the world in prayer and support of the missions. It encourages prayer and financial assistance for the missionary work of the Catholic Church throughout the world. It enables the Gospel, the Good News, to reach millions who have yet to hear it and it supports many who daily experience a significant lack of basic needs.

Accordingly, every parish and diocese throughout the world from the poorest to the most affluent will celebrate this day on Sunday, October 23, 2022. All parishes and dioceses contribute to the universal solidarity fund which is then shared among countries according to their need. Last year, funds raised in Canada (English Sector) went to the support of:

Ethiopia
Namibia
Ghana
India
Sierra Leone
Seychelles Island

The donations that are made on World Mission Sunday support such varied needs in the missions as:

- New Dioceses
- New seminaries to accommodate the increase in vocations
- The rebuilding of areas that have been devastated by natural disaster and/or war
- The rebuilding of the Church where there has been persecution in the recent past and have not been able to hear the Gospel proclaimed to them.
- Construction of Convents, Health Centres and presbyteries.

Your donations are also vital to the daily work of the missionary Church. Your financial assistance provides places of prayer and worship, improved health care and education for the poor and for the needs of our missionaries. Your donations will also go to the training of thousands of catechists who share the Gospel message of love.

World Mission Sunday is coordinated by the Pontifical Mission Societies, specifically the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. Since 1926, Popes have entrusted Society for the Propagation of the Faith to facilitate this important celebration of the missions. The Society provides financial support to every mission diocese throughout the world to become self-sufficient. The Society for the Propagation of Faith works through local bishops, churches, and missionary congregations to ensure that resources are distributed fairly based on need.

Please join the universal Church in these efforts to bring faith, hope, and love to our sisters and brothers in mission countries. World Mission Sunday is a timely opportunity for us to demonstrate that we are missionary disciples.

Collection for World Mission Sunday

The universal collection for World Mission Sunday is unique: its fruits are distributed worldwide according to the needs of the poorest dioceses. Everyone contributes to the cause and this allows the survival of the poorest dioceses, especially those who do not benefit from twinning or privileged contact with the West.

The universal collection provides each bishop the means and freedom of action for the formation of catechists, solidarity, priestly vocations and consecrated life, education, health care, etc. Therefore, it represents a tool of justice and fraternity between all the dioceses. Furthermore, it allows supporting the permanent effort of the Universal Church to go and proclaim the Gospel to all nations. This mandate, received from Christ, is assumed by the baptized people and those who are jointly responsible for the Universal Mission along with the Church of Africa, Asia, South America, Central America, Europe and Oceania.
