Everyone contributes to the cause, and this allows the survival of the poorest dioceses, especially those that do not benefit from twinning or privileged contact with the West. The universal collection provides each bishop the means and freedom of action for the formation of catechists, solidarity, priestly vocations and consecrated life, education, health care, etc. Therefore, it represents a tool of justice and fraternity between all the dioceses. Furthermore, it aids in supporting the permanent effort of the Universal Church to go and proclaim the Gospel to all nations. This mandate, received from Christ, is assumed by the baptized people and those who are jointly responsible for the Universal mission along with the Church of Africa, Asia, South America, Central America, Europe and Oceania. (cf. Statues of the Pontifical Mission Societies/Vatican – Chapter 23, article 8)

Bishops are invited to ask the people in charge of the Catholic organizations and the Christians, to renounce, during all the celebrations of the special Sunday, to any other collection of particular nature. They should also ensure that all donations of World Mission Day are exclusively remitted to the Universal Solidarity Fund, and they should encourage their priests and laity in that spirit. (Article 8)
