In January 2022 she had her first trip to El Salvador as part of a Delegation to witness the Beatification of four martyrs; Rutilio Grande was among them. Maureen's own discernment to become a Sister (early '80's) was profoundly marked by the 1980 Salvadoran martyrdoms of first, Archbishop Oscar Romero, and then Sisters Maura Clarke, Ita Ford, Dorothy Kazel. with lay missionary, Jean Donovan.
