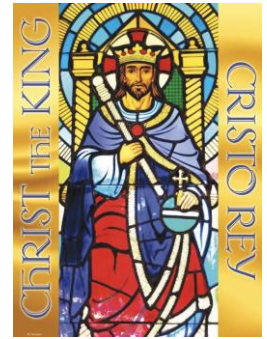

A Special Presentation by Sr. Maureen Wild SC

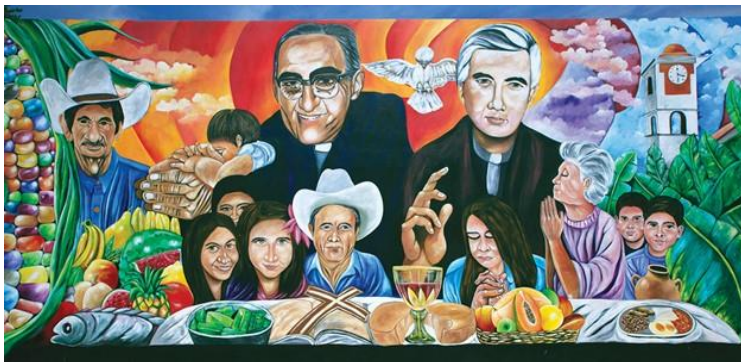

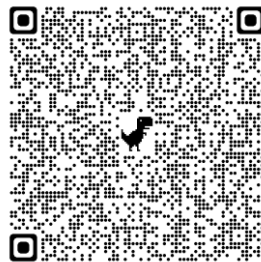
Rutilio Grande García, SJ was assassinated in 1977, along with two other Salvadorans.

Maureen Wild, SC, MEd, is an educator, speaker, and leader of retreats. Her earliest ministries were in the inner cities of Edmonton and Boston. In January 2022 she had her first trip to El Salvador as part of a Delegation to witness the Beatification of four martyrs; Rutilio Grande was among them. Maureen’s own discernment to become a Sister (early ‘80’s) was profoundly marked by the 1980 Salvadoran martyrdoms of first, Archbishop Oscar Romero, and then Sisters Maura Clarke, Ita Ford, Dorothy Kazel. with lay missionary, Jean Donovan.
