Good Friday Collection



Each year at the service on Good Friday we have the collection for the needs of the church in the Holy Land. The Collection brings an indispensable support to the Christian minority of the Holy Land. The State of Israel and Palestine have a population of some 10 million people. So the 180,000 Christian inhabitants represent less than 2% of this population. To check the exodus from the Holy Land of Christians whose lives are rendered particularly difficult, the Franciscan Custody implements numerous initiatives. In addition to ensuring the guard of the shrines, the Good Friday Annual Collection allows the living stones to inhabit the Holy Places and in so doing bear witness to the Resurrection of Christ.



The Bishops of Canada, in coordination with several Catholic organizations, have launched an emergency aid campaign in response to the devastating earthquake that recently hit Turkey and Syria.

Together the CCCB, Aid to Church in Need, Canadian Jesuits International, Catholic Near East Welfare Association, and Development and Peace-Caritas Canada have pledged to raise nearly \$1 million in emergency aid. These four organizations are well positioned in the region to respond quickly and efficiently with many social and emergency initiatives.

Any donations for this emergency aid campaign are <u>**not**</u> to be given through the Sunday collection. Persons should contact the four Catholic agencies as listed in the bulletin if they are interested in donating to this campaign.




Development and Peace: Standing for the Land in Honduras
