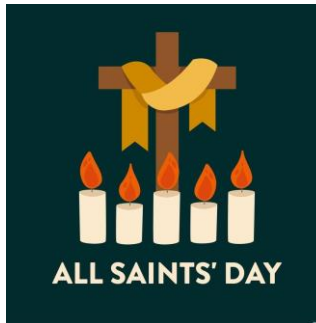

Archbishops Dinner

For the first time since 2019, we will have a public **Archbishop's Dinner** – hosted this year by **Deanery 1** and held at the **Ecole Providence School in McLennan** on **Nov. 3rd**.

Doors will open at 6:00 pm, followed by the dinner at 6:30 pm. Afterwards, Archbishop Pettipas will give a talk and presentation on the topic: **"What makes a church a cathedral"**.
