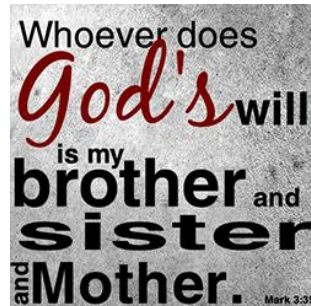

The Catholic Church dedicates the month of June to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**. This tradition dates back to the 17th century when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun, had visions of Jesus Christ revealing His Sacred Heart to her. This devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus became popular and spread throughout the Catholic Church. The Sacred Heart of Jesus Novena prayer was a favorite prayer of St. Padre Pio and he prayed it every day.
